On June 4, 2014 The Office of Community Services (OCS) issued an Information Memorandum (IM) 135 clarifying a technical issue related to the use of CSBG funds as a match for the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance programs administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
